Note:

Members of ECMANCR must have a letter to obtain cemetery plots reserved for

When a death occurs at home, follow these procedures:

In the case of an unexpected death call 911

And wait for the authorities, call your local mosque

No further action needs to be taken.

In case of an expected death

- Call the family doctor or home care nurse. If they are unavailable
- call 911. After that call your local mosque to make an
- arrangement for the funeral
- a. We recommend closing the eyes of the deceased
- immediately using a warm cloth
- b. We recommend Binding the lower jaw to the head by
- wrapping a scarf around the face and tying it up to
- ensure that the jaw does not hang.
- c. There can be an attempt to straighten the limbs,
- however, be sure not to use a forceful manner.
- d. The deceased should be covered entirely with a clean
- Sheet.

Currently the following funeral services are provided by

Mosques in Ottawa

Funeral services offered by the Mosques include:

 Assistance in obtaining all necessary documents for release and burial of the body

- Transportation of the body to the mosque, as well as to the cemetery
- Tahseel (washing of the body)
- Takfeen (preparing of the body)
- Low cost coffin (at cost price)
- Cold storage in case of delayed burial
- Kafan and all necessary required articles
- Janazah

Costs:

- a. Mosque Service costs \$1,200 for the coffin, etc.
- b.The Ottawa Muslim Cemetery charges \$1,200 for opening and closing of the grave.
- c. The cost of an adult burial lot is \$1500 plus tax at the Ottawa Muslim Cemetery. (Members of ECMANCR are exempted from this cost.)

Please Note; The Mosque requires the following information:

- Full name of the deceased
- Date of Death
- His/her Date of Birth
- City Or Province where the deceased was born
(If its outside of Canada state the country)
- Relationship Status (Single, Married, Divorce)
- Full Name of Partner
- Address where the deceased resided in
- His/her occupation
- His/her age at the time of death
- Place of death (Address where the deceased died)
- Mothers Full name
- Fathers full name
- City Or Province where Parents were born (If its outside of Canada state the country)

Once you contact one of the Mosque funeral volunteers or the Mosque office staff, they will discuss the process with you in detail and help you fill out the paperwork and make the necessary arrangements.

Trust the volunteers to help you so you can focus on comforting the family and attending to your visitors. Although the Mosque funeral volunteers will help you every step of the way, we encourage family members to familiarize themselves with the process.

The following procedures are applicable if you don't require Mosque funeral services.

1. If death occurs at home:

Call your family doctor (or the last doctor the patient had seen) for a home visit (for the due process) and issuance of a Medical Certificate of Death (Form 16) or call 911 and the body will be transported by an ambulance to the Hospital where after the due a Medical Certificate of Death (Form 16) will be issued and the body will remain in the Morgue until the other formalities are completed.

2. If death occurs in the Hospital:

Hospital will complete the due process and issue a MedicalCertificate of Death (Form 16) and the body will remain in the Morgue until the other formalities are completed.

- 3. Obtain a Statement of Death (Form 15) from the Mosque or from City hall.
- **4.** Contact Cemetery and arrange for the burial and opening and closing of the grave: An appointment will be set to meet to sign the required documents and make payment.
- 5. The Cemetery will require the burial permit issued by the City of Ottawa before the grave can be opened.

Bring both forms (Form 15, Statement of Death & Form16, Medical Certificate of Death to obtain a Death Registration, also called a Burial Permit from Ottawa City Hall.

(24 hour service is provided at 10 Laurier Avenue West, Ottawa, Ontario, K1P 1J1, telephone # 580-2400 – After office hours, one has to inform the security guard (main door) that you are here for a burial-permit and you will be escorted to a City official)

3 of which are listed below, between 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday (after hours, weekends and holidays go to the City Hall address above).

The City will immediately issue a burial-permit upon submission of the fee and both forms (Form 15 & 16).

The fee to register a death in the City of Ottawa is \$64.

Please make a few copies of these important documents.

Only upon issuance of a burial permit by the City, the hospital will release the body from the Hospital.

PLEASE NOTE: The cemetery will only open the grave upon issuance of a burial-permit by the City (exception being a fetus, in this case a burial permit may not be issued).

The family will be required to bring two pieces of ID, Health Card and SIN number for the deceased, and fill out required forms.

Financial Assistance for Cremation and Burials

- Financial assistance is available for cremation and burial costs for:
- Individuals who were in receipt of social assistance at the time of their death;
- Low-income residents who were receiving, or would have been eligible to receive, assistance under the City's Essential Health and Social Supports program (EHSS).
- Family members must apply for financial assistance prior to signing a contract with a funeral home.
- An application for financial assistance can be made by calling 3-1-1
 between the hours of 8:45 am and 4:00 pm:

- Select 4 for Social Services

- Staff (from the Social Services Center will review the circumstances of the deceased to determine if assistance with Cremation and/ or burial costs is possible.
